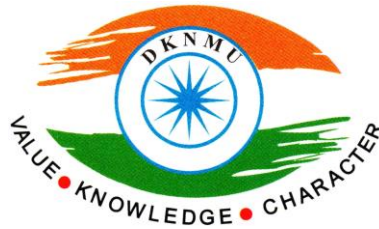

1. **Introduction:** Write about your topic (Maximum 3 pages).
2. **Review of literature:** Writes previous work, which has done by other researcher related to your topic (Maximum 8 Pages). [All related references must write in text and give detail in reference heading. You are giving references as in superscript (e.g. chiral phosphoric acid catalyzed enantioselective bromocyclization of olefins.¹ You may use alphabetic form also, (e.g. Huang et al 2011). Up to 30 latest references must be included in synopsis.
3. **Objectives:** Write objectives in point wise (either in bullet form or numeric style)-
 - Objective 1
 - Objective 2
 - Objective 3 & So on.....
4. **Work Plan & Methodology:** (Maximum 2 pages).
 - 4.1. **Hypothesis** (if Applicable): (Maximum 2 pages).
 - 4.2. **Methodology:** According to your topic & objectives, decide experiments and write methods of the experiments (step wise) (Maximum 4 pages), write references with the experiment as suggested in review of literature.
 - 4.3. **Work Plan:** Work plan about experiments time line, after every six month (Maximum 3 pages).
5. **References:** All the references must be given properly as per the given format.

The Ph.D. Scholar should follow the following standards for typing and printing of the Ph.D. Synopsis-

1. In MS Word format, Font size 12 for English in Times New Roman; Font size 14 for Hindi in Kurti Dev 010 font.
2. Margins: Left: 1.5 Inches, Right: 1.0 Inch, Top: 1.0 Inch, Bottom: 1.0 Inch, with 1.5 line spacing on A4 Size Paper One-side printing.
